Telit announces MoU for new EU initiative

Telit Communications plc (AIM:TCM), the global wireless communications developer and distributor, announces that it has signed a Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") with the European Commission's Emergency Call ("eCall") initiative. The purpose of the MoU is to secure EU-wide commitment to creating an in-vehicle emergency call service to reduce the number of fatalities and accidents on European roads.

By 2009 the initiative will be fully implemented and the directive will require that all European vehicles are fitted with a standardised on-board emergency call system. In the event of an accident the on-board eCall system will send an alert signal to the ambulance, police and fire brigade services. The signal can be sent either manually or automatically if the car flips over or the airbag is activated. When activated the in-vehicle eCall system will establish a voice connection directly with the relevant Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP"). At the same time, a minimum set of incident data ("MDS") will be sent to the eCall operator receiving the voice call.

Oozi Cats, Chief Executive of Telit, commented: "Telit understands the future importance of in-vehicle communications. An on-board GSM-based emergency call system can significantly shorten the time it takes emergency services to be deployed.

"Telit is able to contribute to this activity with its long-term experience in cellular communication systems. The consequence of the eCall campaign is that all cars sold from 2009 will be equipped with GPRS modules and Telit will be at the forefront of the campaign and will be able to position itself as a key supplier.

"Telit believes, as a result of this campaign, there will be a marked increase in in-vehicle safety. This will not only make European roads safer but will also bring commercial success for the parties involved."
