

# Proposal: Re-launch of the RTTI WG

- **RTTI = Real-Time Traffic [and Traveller] Information**

The RTTI WG, established in 2003, presented a Final Report with 12 Recommendations October 2005. Since, further development in the field of RTTI has taken place –  
but: open issues are remaining with respect to the RTTI-structure, implementation, recommended measures, and further roll-out.

There is a need for decision on consecutive work, definition of further steps and harmonisation – optionally with focus on “Traffic” (only?)

It is proposed, to re-launch the RTTI Working Group with up-dated objectives, structure, deliverables, and time-frame.

# Objectives and Scope of Work (1)

- **Review of the results and recommendations of the Final Report and analysis of open issues.**

The review should deliver already made improvements, but also still existing obstacles and difficulties of implementation.

- **Focus on traffic related criteria, expectations, and needs.**

Definition of the constituent elements of RTTI out of the

- user perspectives
- traffic policy perspectives, especially related to road traffic safety
- traffic management perspectives

## Objectives and Scope of Work (2)

- **Proposal of a “Road Map” for implementation of RTTI**

Given different starting conditions, existing and evolving technologies, standards, and applications a future-proven approach is necessary for a consistent co-operation of involved stake-holders

- **Proposal for the Commission on further actions**

Member States should be encouraged to implement RTTI in order to reach a continuously improving European level of quality and services related to traffic information and safety

# Structure of the Working Group

- **Members**

The group necessarily needs participation of all involved stakeholders as highway and road traffic authorities, broadcasting corporations, automotive and equipment industry, service providers, and specific experts on RTTI
