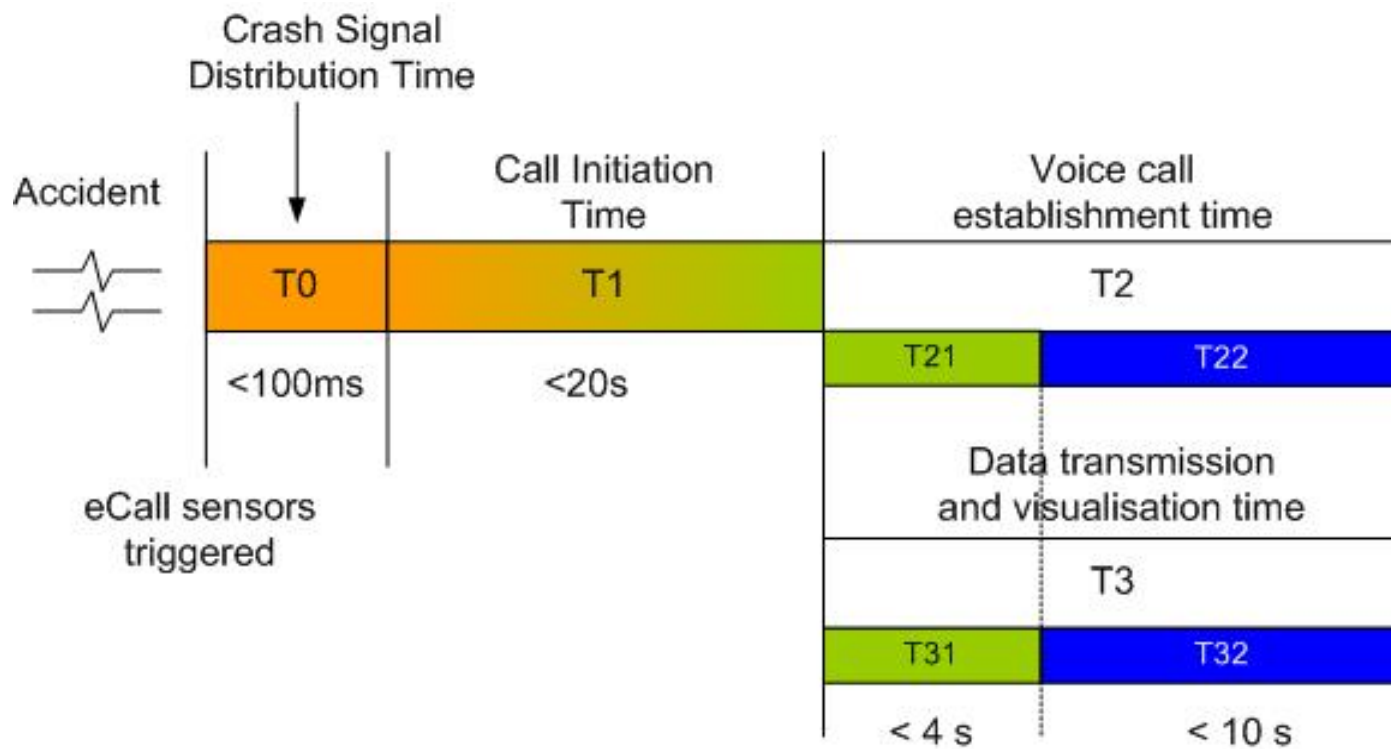

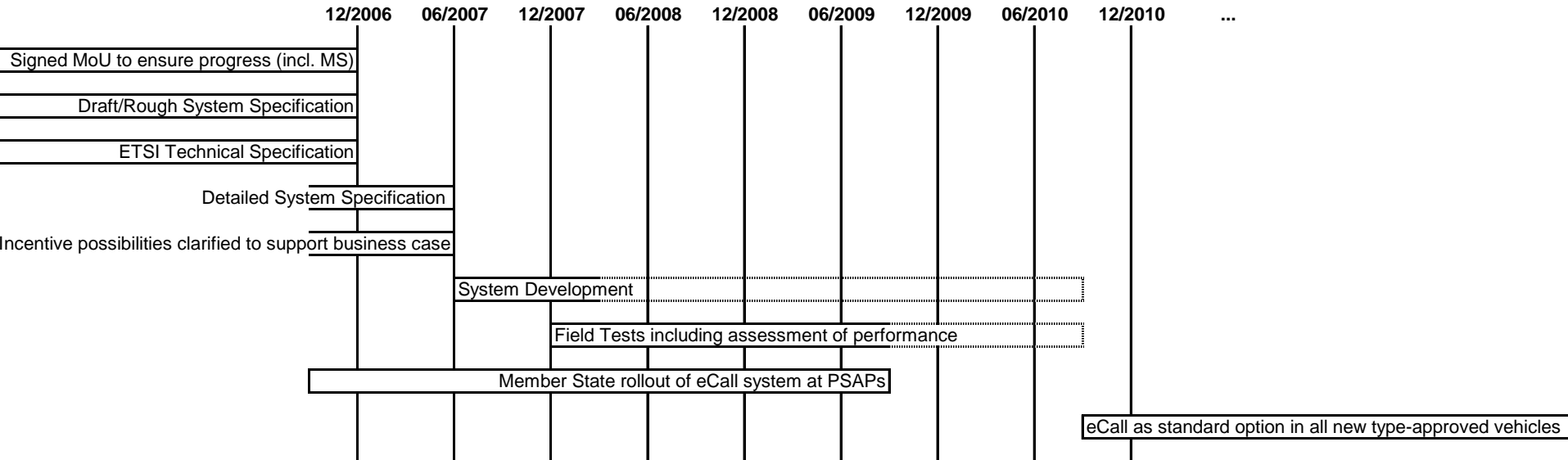
# end2end Performance criteria

# Final recommendations

---



- o Member States to signing the MoU.
  - o The European Commission to pursue the deployment of eCall including follow the ongoing standardization
  - o eSafety Support to continue providing the necessary support
  - o All Stakeholders to prepare for the deployment according to the roadmap given
  - o Establishment of large scale field operational tests and assessments of eCall
  - o Establish a permanent group of emergency authorities and other relevant stakeholders
  - o Recommends that private service providers providing experiences to Member States
  - o stakeholders to carry out adequate awareness and education campaign to the citizens on eCall

# Actions 2006

---



- o Can VIN be used as vehicle identification (*EC*)
  - o Encoding of MSD (*RESCUE*) + standardisation
  - o Member States to sign MoU (*EC/eSS*)
    - Paper on PSAP workload (*eSS*)
    - Data privacy issues (*EC*)
  - o Will Member States allow eCall without a SIM (*EC*)
  - o Set up meeting with SP (*eSS*)
  - o Monitor ETSI\_MSG standardisation (*EC*)
