eSafety WG RTD: Last Meeting

 - Only WG Communication and WG Implementation give inputs

eSafety WG RTD: “Lead Market”

(Status 2007 Sept -)

- “Lead Market” issue/study
 - Unclear what the Steering Group wants
 - Lead Market is beyond RTD
 - eRTD is not necessarily the best suited WG.
WG Implementation may be better for this task

- Recommendation:
 - SG to specify why, what is needed, by whom, with what resources, ...

eSafety WG RTD: International Collaboration

(Status 2007 Sept -)

- International Collaboration
 - Recognised as important for R&D, FOTs, Standards, Industrial and commercial dimension.
 - However, today the Inter. Collab. seems to be ad hoc, “travel money” and position making for some, lack of strategic approach.

 - Identify strategic topics
 - Identify appealing regions and partners
 - Characterise benefits for Europe
 - Influence FP7 ICT Workprogram
